



Anwärter Ski (level I) 1) Kitzbühel / Dezember 2011

Target group:

Those taking the first step into the occupation of ski instructing.

Goal of the training:

To be able to control and perform a ski lesson according to the manual on a safe slope, with competent knowledge of the theory and practise required. There is also a basic introduction into the teaching of snowboard.

Contents:

At the start of the course the skiing ability of each candidate will be assessed.

These subjects will be covered in the theory: teaching of movements and lesson steps, equipment knowledge, Childrens lessons, first aid, knowledge of the environment and nature, introduction to the general trends of the sport (alternative snow sports) and tourism.

The practical side is centralised around the basics of skiing. How to demonstrate the basic exercises for adults and children according to the manual, with an understanding of the learning steps.

In taking control of the lesson, the correct teaching steps will be demonstrated and explained. You will be examined on your ability to teach the group and your knowledge of the correct learning procedure will be tested. The key to a successful teacher is to be able to see faults and put them right in the correct way. There is also a basic introduction into the teaching of snowboard.

Certificate:

Each candidate will receive a certificate after the successful completion of the course. This allows you to begin teaching at a basic level. An Anwarter (level I) instructor is allowed to teach on the slope whilst employed by a Ski School.

The Ski School laws require that you have the Austrian Anwarter (level I) qualification or a qualification of a similar standard before you begin to teach.

Beware: applicants with foreign qualifications outside of the Alps, even those of the highest standard, may still be required to take the Anwarter (level I).

Participant requirements:

- ▶ You need to have **registered** in writing by the **25 th of November 2011 at the latest**.
- ▶ You need to be 16 years of age or older by the day of the test.
- ▶ You need written confirmation from your Doctor that you are physically fit enough to participate.
- ▶ You need to be capable of safely descending an intermediate (red) slope. If you are unable to ski to this ability you will not be permitted to enter the course. If this is the case your course fees will be refunded.

What to bring with you:

- ▶ Your own Ski clothing
- ▶ Complete Ski equipment
- ▶ Complete Snowboard equipment (during the Anwärter course/you can also rent this when you need it)
